These advancements combine for three significant benefits: higher speaker efficiency (92dB), an easier impedance curve enabling lower wattage power amps to be used, and a seamless and coherent integration between electrostatic panel and dynamic woofer with deep, articulate bass down to 34 Hz.

Ethos' 24-Bit Vojtko DSP Engine and 200-watt digital subwoofer amplifier creates powerful, detailed bass from a custom designed front-firing 8-inch aluminum-cone woofer and precisely matched down-firing 8-inch passive radiator.

The passive radiator enhances bass output, much like a port, but without port induced noise and midrange resonance.


